In general the meeting was good with many very good comments about Bakken Oil trains but mostly about access across the railroad tracks. Basically the comments urged common sense in allowing crossing of the tracks. All in attendance agreed the law in place now takes away our rights to use public land. The proposed crossings will do little to solve the access problems. Most attendees looked at the proposed crossings as a waste of our money as BNSF is looking for govt money to do the crossings. In other words, if it isn't broke, don't fix it. Many comments were made that no one can remember when a hunter or fisher was hit by a train. Hopefully something good will come out of these meetings and legislative efforts to change the law so that we can once again have access.
