A meeting was set for the following day at Kirschbaum's house for anyone available to write the club's by-laws from the 1991 draft. When completed a special meeting wase held to vote on same. Kirschbaum was given permission to contact local sportsman's club regarding a DNR PFD loaner board at the Woodman Landing. This board would also have a throwable PFD for use at the nearby beach in the event of a water emergency at that location. New club T-shirts are in and will be available from Kirschbaum. Three bat house prototypes that are proposed to be placed at La Riviere Park were displayed. A motion to provide \$100 for the Turkey Hunters Care program was passed.

Thanks go out to all who helped at the pre-deer season sight-in. Weather, except for Friday afternoon, was nice for shooters and range officers. Those members involved included Jess Hollenbeck, Joe Prew, Pete Adkins, Jim Barbian, Dennis Kirschbaum, Rick Lange, and John Yager. \$99 was collected from the donation box during the 5 day sight-in effort. 95 shooters came to the range to sight-in. As usual several scopes had problems and many more were sighted in after being bore sighted. Only one malfunctioning firearm was found.
